



2009 MorSoy Grower Point of Sale (GPOS) Reporting

- All MorSoy soybean sales are to be reported to Cache River Valley Seed.
- **The deadline for reporting MorSoy soybeans sales is JULY 31, 2009.**
- All reported growers must have a valid 2009 Monsanto Technology Card or they must sign a 2009 Monsanto Stewardship agreement prior to July 31, 2009.
- **If you sell MorSoy soybeans to another wholesaler, you must report that sale. In addition, you are responsible for reporting the retail sales of the wholesaler you sold to.**
- A reporting form is provided with this program book. If you prefer, we will email you an Excel spreadsheet reporting form to use instead.
- **Any additional MorSoy soybean sales or credits memos that occur after you have turned in your GPOS reporting should be reported to CRVS promptly.**

Monsanto Grower Point of Sale (GPOS) Reporting

- All Asgrow and Dekalb corn, soybean and grain sorghum sales are to be reported to Monsanto.
- **The deadline for reporting Asgrow/Dekalb sales is JULY 31, 2009.**
- All reported growers must have a valid 2007 Monsanto Technology Card or they must sign a 2007 Monsanto Stewardship agreement by July 31, 2009.
- Asgrow and Dekalb products are to be reported via www.farmsource.com.
- In order to qualify for the 2009 Action Pact Initiative, 100% of GPOS data must be reported to Monsanto. The submitted GPOS data will also fulfill the EPA requirement for crops containing the YeildGuard trait.
